Minutes of the last meeting:

Les VK3TEX circulated the minutes of the last meeting to the members for their perusal. He moved the motion that they be passed by the members. Seconded by Terry VK3MAR. Carried.

Correspondence:

Show n Tell

From Steve VK3DAG

Here is the Variable Frequency Oscillator (VFO) of project "X".

Project X is a project that I am undertaking to build a multiband HF transceiver from discrete components. This is not a kit in any way. But built from text books and the Internet sources.

The VFO is a simple Vackar oscillator. J113 FET's are used for the VFO and first buffer amp. The second buffer amp uses two 2N3904 transistors in tandem. The first buffer amp drives a frequency counter/stabiliser. The second drives the double balanced mixer.

One pole of a double pole, six way switch is used for band switching the individual coils. The other pole is used to supply DC to the Band Pass Filter (BPF) and Low Pass Filter (LPF) boards. Yet to be built.



The capacitors should be polystyrene, silvered mica, or NPO ceramic types. This is to help stop frequency drift. Also the VFO is built in a shielded box to help with drift as well. I used a good quality air spaced tuning capacitor with anti-backlash reduction drive.

The inductors are wound on a ceramic former. You can find these in old strip heaters. Each coil in the VFO has the needed turns for each particular band tank circuit.

Next part of the project is the VFO stabiliser/frequency counter

offset circuit.

Hi All,

Just a quick update on VK3RGV B our D-STAR Repeater. It is now fully operational and running with its new gateway from my home location in Toolamba West.

The small black box in the photo is the gateway server that runs on 12 volts. Its is an Intel Atom running 2 GB ram and an 80GB solid state hard drive. The computer itself draws close to 0.8 amps and produces very little heat. The hard drive will also put up with a much higher heat than normal hard drive.

The repeater is covering about 30-40km local radius from my place and will be located here for a couple of months to ensure all bugs are ironed out before the system is installed on Mt Wombat.



It will be linked to Reflector 3C for the moment however if anyone wants to connect it to something else feel free. All systems are fully operational including DV Dongles and DVAP If you have any questions please feel free to drop me an email or give me a call.
