It is with disappointment that Canoeing Victoria and the Yarrawonga Mulwala Canoe Club have made the decision to cancel the Murray Quad event in 2012.

Despite the event being ready to run and great support from the local organizations and Council, lack of entries have unfortunately not made the event viable this year. Feedback from potential competitors stated that it is a fantastic event that they will take on next year, but the lead time from promotion to event this year was not sufficient to prepare for such a challenge.

To address these issues, Canoeing Victoria will be confirming the date for 2013 in January in consultation with the World Quadrathlon Federation as well as promoting the event earlier and providing course familiarization sessions in the local Yarrawonga area throughout the year.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your support to date and look forward to a partnership with you for the 2013 event.

We will continue to support and promote the local area by holding the first of these familiarization sessions on the 15th December in Yarrawonga. It will include the full 19.5km course run and a paddling equipment expo on the

Saturday afternoon followed by a paddling training session with the Yarrawonga canoe club on the Sunday morning.

Entry fees already paid will be fully refunded and entrants will be notified accordingly in the coming week. Once again it is with disappointment that we have had to cancel the event, but we look forward to it being a successful event in 2013.
